

ETHICAL CODE of the Opticians of New Brunswick

To uphold and advance the honour, integrity and high standards of the optical dispensing profession, its members must:

- a) Be honest and impartial in serving the public and the profession,*
- b) Strive to increase the competence and prestige of the profession,*
- c) Keep abreast of technical and educational advancements in the optical dispensing field,*
- d) Respect the dignity and professional status of their colleagues and the professional relationship between their colleagues and the public,*
- e) Use their knowledge and skills to improve the health and well-being of the public,*
- f) Protect the health of the public at all times by delegating duties or procedures only to a person who is qualified by training AND registered with the Association as a person able to perform that duty or procedure,*
- g) Fulfill all medically based instructions of the Optometrist/Ophthalmologist and do everything possible in conjunction with him/her to conserve human eyesight.*
